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Portions of FORT OGLETHORPE MEDICAL OFFICERS' TRAINING CAMP, 1917-1918, were written as a Medical Heritage Project for the Walker - Catoosa - Dade Medical Auxiliary. It has been greatly revised with many additions made including rosters of the medical officers, enlisted men, ambulance companies, Red Cross Units, sanitary companies, field hospitals, evacuation hospitals, and National Guard Detachments. Now, in 1987, due to its historical and genealogical significance, the Delta Genealogical Society has chosen to publish it.

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FORT OGLETHORPE MEDICAL OFFICERS' TRAINING CAMP 1917-1918

Fort Oglethorpe, Georgia, named for James Oglethorpe, first governor of Georgia, was established as a military base in 1902 and formerly opened in 1904. It had been used at various times as home of the First, Third, Sixth, Seventh, Eleventh, Twelfth, and Sixteenth Cavalries. The Sixth Cavalry was stationed there from 1919 until 1942, when complete motorization was accomplished, and the era of horses was gone forever at Fort Oglethorpe.

In 1917, a training camp for medical officers was established. In both World Wars I and II, a prison for prisoners of war was established. Fort Oglethorpe served as an induction center in World War II, and in 1943, the Women's Third Army Corps was there. After World War II in 1946, the government decided to retire the post, and in 1947, the entire establishment was declared surplus. On July 31, 1947, the War Assets Administration approved the transfer of the Fort Oglethorpe post hospital and ninety acres with facilities to the Hospital Authority of Walker, Catoosa and Dade Counties. Tri-County Hospital opened on November 8, 1953, on the site of the old post hospital. On November 8, 1975, the new wing of John L. Hutcheson Memorial Hospital was dedicated with Senator Herman Talmadge as speaker. The old post hospital, now in 1987, serves as the doctors' building which is connected to the hospital. The entire complex is now called the Hutcheson Medical Center.

The focal point for this article will be the years 1917-1918 when Fort Oglethorpe and Chickamauga Battlefield were the site of the Medical Officers' Training Camp, which was later named Camp Greenleaf, whose Commandant was Colonel Henry Page.

Camp Greenleaf was located in the battlefield itself, and by the end of World War I was known as the "West Point of Medicine". This quote was from an article by Mr. Vincent S. Gannon entitled, "Fort Oglethorpe - A Story of Conflict and Cooperation between the Army and the Chickamauga Battlefield". Mr. Gannon also stated in his article that Camp McLean was a crash training program for officers, and Camp Nathan Bedford Forest was a training site for infantry and engineers. Therefore, the idea that Fort Oglethorpe was only a cavalry post is erroneous.

Jean K. Buckley of the Georgia Department of Natural Resources wrote an article entitled, "Brief History of Fort Oglethorpe Military Post". In this article she stated:

During World War I, three contiguous camps were enjoying separate existences in the area. During this war, troops marched in mass formations in the streets, wooden barracks grew up among the monuments on the battlefield and on the post grounds, polo teams vied in the polo grounds on Barnhardt Circle and trenches and war games spun across the nearby countryside. By 1918, over 1600 post buildings were on the expanded Fort Oglethorpe and over 60,000 troops had been mobilized through the post. Around Barnhardt Circle were the detention camps for the German prisoners of war and enemy aliens. To the west was the post hospital, site of the present Tri-County Memorial facility. On the Camp Greenleaf site, one of the camps which merged into the Fort Oglethorpe Post, the Army established a medical and sanitary corps. Many of the horse drawn ambulances which drew their way across the War's battlefields had their origin at Fort Oglethorpe, where the formation and training was a Camp Greenleaf specialty.

History can only come alive by relating it to events which are familiar to us. For example, to think about events at Fort Oglethorpe in 1917-1918, one must think of events going on in the rest of the world. Woodrow Wilson was President of the United States, and many battles were taking place in Europe. The German attack on Verdun was March 5, 1917; the French had battle successes in Champagne. There was fighting on the Hindenburg line, and in August the French captured Verdun. There was a young Lieutenant named Dwight David Eisenhower who was an instructor in trench warfare at Fort Oglethorpe, and tradition is that he lived in one of the houses around

Barnhardt Circle. This was mentioned in an article in the News Free Press on December 22, 1946, and in the Guide Book of the Fort Oglethorpe Preservation Society. The tank made its first appearance on the war scene, and there were a few airplanes which were used mainly for observation or reconnaissance. "Eddie" Rickenbacker was one of the aces of World War I. Shell shock became a new term, and gas was used as a weapon by the Germans.

With these events in mind, the Medical Officers' Training Camp opened at Fort Oglethorpe on June 1, 1917. First Lieutenant James Raulston Wells wrote a book called Medical Training Camp Fort Oglethorpe, Georgia complete with many pictures of the camp and its officers and enlisted men. Lieutenant Wells stated there was a monumental task facing Colonel Henry Page, the Commandant. From this Medical Officers' Training Camp, Colonel Page developed the field hospitals, ambulance companies, the evacuation hospitals, sanitary companies, the base hospital, regimental detachments and the Red Cross Units.

Colonel Henry Page, Commandant of the Medical Training Camp, which in 1918 was to be known as Camp Greenleaf, was born September 1, 1870 in Maryland. Therefore, he was forty-seven years old at the point of his tour of duty at Fort Oglethorpe. He was the son of Henry Page, Congressman and later Judge in the Maryland Court of Appeals. Colonel Page graduated from Princeton in 1891, from the University of Pennsylvania School of Medicine in 1894. He married Edith Longfellow Greenleaf of Louisville, Kentucky. Their three sons were Henry, Charles, and John. In 1916, Colonel Page was in charge of the typhoid epidemic at Camp Whitman, New York, where there were approximately 4,000 cases of typhoid. Prior to his duty at Fort Oglethorpe, he was stationed as an instructor in military medicine at the University of Pennsylvania. His biographer, Lieutenant McKenna, describes Colonel Page as being "an ideal father, a lovable companion and parent". Colonel Page is credited with being the driving force in creating the medical camp on Chickamauga Battlefield and molding the physicians into a cooperating unit. Colonel Page founded the first sanitary company, and the first evacuation hospital ever formed as part of the United States Army. So, there were several firsts at Fort Oglethorpe directly due to Colonel Page's leadership.

From this description, one can conclude that Colonel Page was indeed an unusual doctor and army officer. Colonel Page gave an efficiency banquet every week to encourage cleanliness, esprit de corps and efficiency in paper work. Each company who won the award was allowed to hang the banner which said in large letters, "DO IT WELL, DO IT CHEERFULLY, DO IT NOW, and lastly, SMILE".

Immediately under Colonel Page was Lieutenant Roger Brooke who was born November 5, 1870 in Ohio. He graduated from Baltimore Medical College in 1900 and later graduated from the Army Medical School in 1902. Later, at the dedication of the Warden McLean Auditorium, Colonel Brooke told of Colonel Page's accomplishments of making Camp Greenleaf a reality by turning a marshland with no buildings into a medical camp.

The Field Hospital was commanded by Lieutenant Colonel Robert Carswell. The object of the field hospital was to receive the sick and wounded from an ambulance company and care for them until they could be evacuated. There were four field hospitals at Fort Oglethorpe during this period: numbers 21, 22, 23, and 24. Twenty-one and Twenty-three were horse drawn, and Twenty-two and Twenty-four were motor drawn. Lieutenant Wells described these field hospitals as being located on a hill overlooking the Medical Officers' Training Camp. He stated that the location was one of the coolest and beautiful and one could see Missionary Ridge and Lookout Mountain in the background.

The Sanitary Company which was Colonel Page's specialty had as its object to send every soldier into the firing line free from disease, and had four main objectives which were: (1) controlling insects, (2) disposing of all kitchen and toilet waste, (3) drainage, and (4) personal hygiene. Lieutenant Wells stated that the fly was considered the worst enemy. He stated that fly traps and poison were put out and every man was supplied with a fly swatter, and the daily motto was "to kill the fly!".

Camp Greenleaf was the name given in 1918 to the Medical Officers' Training Camp. It was named for General Charles R. Greenleaf, a distinguished officer for the Medical Department of the Army. This camp was set up among the

monuments at Chickamauga Battlefield, which is the nation's oldest and largest National Military Park, established in 1890. Mr. Vincent Gannon in his article about Fort Oglethorpe said that this encampment was remarkably free from disease. Unfortunately, the influenza epidemic of 1918 was yet to come. Camp Greenleaf reached its largest size on September 1, 1918, when 2,915 officers and 23,144 enlisted men were stationed at the camp. These men had a camp newspaper called The Camp Life with many pictures of the commanding officers and companies. Some of the songs which they sang were listed as follows: "The Star Spangled Banner", "Over There", "Where Do We Go From Here", and "Hail Hail the Gang's All Here".

One of the significant events at Camp Greenleaf was the dedication of the Warden McLean Auditorium on March 11, 1918. The Auditorium was given in memory of Lieutenant Warden McLean who was killed at the first officers' training camp. Mrs. McLean of Philadelphia gave the auditorium in honor of her son. It contained seven large classrooms, (one of which was an orthopedic museum), and an auditorium which could seat 1,000 people. It was situated directly in the center of Camp Greenleaf on the Chickamauga Battlefield itself. The architecture was of the Frank Lloyd Wright style and was designed by Lieutenant Outwater of the Sanitary Corps. He had previously designed the "Little House" of Colonel Page and the Officers' Club. In civilian life, Lieutenant Outwater was associated with the firm of Edwin Outwater, Inc., New York. The dedication was attended by many well-known physicians of the United States. In connection with the ceremony, some statistics were listed in the Chattanooga Sunday Times on March 10, 1918. As of March 10th, the newspaper listed 4,000 officers and 20,000 enlisted men were trained at Camp Greenleaf. The staff as of that date consisted of two hundred fifty officers, 2,000 student officers and 10,000 men.

Lieutenant Colonel Roger Brooke introduced Colonel Page at the dedication ceremony which was at 10:00 A.M. on March 11, 1918. Colonel Page was greeted with much applause and approval. He then introduced Major General William C. Gorgas, Surgeon General of the United States Army, who delivered an address. General Gorgas had achieved fame for his work against yellow fever in the

Panama Canal Zone. He referred to the fact that Camp Greenleaf was to triple in size and said it would be the "medical West Point of the South". After the dedication, luncheon followed for all of the out of town guests and for the Chattanooga Rotary Club. A vaudeville show put on by the men of Camp Greenleaf was given for entertainment for General Gorgas in the evening. A partial list of eminent physicians attending the dedication is as follows:

The General Medical Board of the Council of Defense met on March 10, 1918 at Camp Greenleaf because so many medical dignitaries had come for the dedication of the Warden McLean Auditorium. This meeting was usually held in Washington, D.C. General Gorgas announced that for the first time all medical personnel had been classified, and this information was available so that the medical board of the Council of National Defense could know at any time which individuals and group of doctors were available for specific tasks. It was reported there was a shortage of nurses in the civilian sector.

Shortly after the dedication of the Warden McLean Auditorium, Colonel Page received overseas orders, and Brigadier General H. P. Birmingham became

the new commandant of Camp Greenleaf. In the Chattanooga Daily Times on December 5, 1918, Colonel W. N. Bispham was mentioned as being Commandant of Camp Greenleaf. In the Chattanooga Times on December 18, 1918, it was announced that Brigadier General William S. Scott was to assume command of all military personnel in the Park (referring to Chickamauga National Military Park) including Camp Greenleaf.

Another important event at Camp Greenleaf which had dire consequences was the "Spanish Influenza" epidemic which took its toll at all of the camps at Fort Oglethorpe. In the Chattanooga Times on October 9, 1918 is a caption entitled "All Schools Now Closed". This story included a health order by then Mayor Jesse Littleton, H. D. Huffaker, Commissioner of Health and Education, and C. P. Knight of the U.S. Public Health Service. The order stated that all places of public gathering such as public schools, private schools, the University of Chattanooga, business colleges, churches, Sunday schools, missions, movies, theaters, pool rooms and dance halls were to be closed, which order became effective at six A.M. on October 9, 1918. Major Williamson of Fort Oglethorpe attended the meeting and explained how influenza germs could be spread by coughing, spitting, and sneezing.

By October 14, 1918, there were reported to be 2,840 cases of influenza at Camp Greenleaf. Dr. T. S. McCallie, who was chairman of the Red Cross in Chattanooga, sent extra nurses to Hospital 14 at Camp Greenleaf. This was reported in the Chattanooga Times on October 14, 1918, p. 5. Also reported at that time were the deaths of the following soldiers:

By October 15, 1918, it was announced that Camp Greenleaf was quarantined with only emergency town leaves. At this time, 2,817 cases of the influenza were reported at General Hospital 14. The newspaper caption at that time read, "Epidemic Is On Decline". Dr. James Livingood in his Centennial History of the Chattanooga and Hamilton County Medical Society (1983) listed total cases of influenza in the Chattanooga area were 5,800 by mid-October on pages 72-73.

The end of World War I came on November 11, 1918 when Armistice was declared, and as early as November 13, 1918, it was announced in the Chattanooga Daily Times on page 12 that seventy-five medical officers were leaving Camp Greenleaf immediately for field service. By December 5, 1918, the Chattanooga Times had a caption, "Hospital 14 Is Large Enough". Colonel W. N. Bispham, then Commandant of Camp Greenleaf, announced that no additional enlargement of Hospital 14 was being considered. At that time, Hospital 14 had a capacity of 2600 beds. For those of us today, this was an incredible amount of beds for a hospital which was located on Chickamauga Battlefield itself. The present capacity of Hutcheson Medical Center is approximately two hundred fifty beds.

On December 18, 1918, an announcement was in the Chattanooga Daily Times stating that Brigadier General William Scott was to assume command of all military personnel in the Chickamauga Park including Camp Greenleaf. Colonel W. N. Bispham, announced the evacuation of Camp Greenleaf. All medical officers were to be assigned to other base hospitals around the United States. The enlisted personnel were discharged, and it was predicted that by the third week in January, 1919, all enlisted men would be discharged. The article entitled, "Evacuation of Greenleaf" appeared in the Chattanooga Daily Times on December 18, 1918, and it heralded the end of Camp Greenleaf and with it all hopes of future plans for expansion were finished.

This article dealing with the years 1917-1918 at Fort Oglethorpe took a different turn than I had anticipated when starting the research. I had thought of Fort Oglethorpe primarily as the home of the Sixth Cavalry and
